- To develop skating and motor skills through natural learning phases (introduction, acquisition, retention/mastery).
- To use skill progression and repetition throughout the six stages to introduce physical literacy and establish quality basic skating skills.
- To foster personal achievements and satisfaction through skill acquisition, rewards and recognition and to evoke a life-long interest in skating.

The six stages concentrate on **BALANCE, CONTROL and AGILITY**. Lessons consist of instruction up to twice per week, and are taught by Professional Coaches and qualified Program Assistants, all High Five Certified. Programs include: weekly incentives, theme days, Santa Skate and a great Annual Ice Show experience.
